II.Old Business

Constructed 7 signs for various locations along the creek to post informational and regulatory signage. The troop installed six posts and delivered one to the farmer to install. Holes were dug with an auger, cement was added and the posts were installed. Luke went back the following weekend to take off the braces, put on the plexiglass and put up the signs. Great job Luke!!
