### **I.Treasury Report**

- Budget update

- Luke Wiley presented his Eagle Scout Project (Little Beaver Creek Stocked Trout Water Sign Project). Constructing 7 signs for various locations along the creek to post informational and regulatory signage. Fish and Game Commission is getting permission from property owners to install signs. Would like to begin in January 2019 and complete

by March 2019. Need approximately 12 helpers. Approximate cost is \$1250. He will ask for donations of materials and funds. Ken Neumann can provide safety glasses and work gloves for the project. Luke plans on constructing the signs at his house or a scout meeting and then planning a work day to install the signs in concrete at each site. Parents asked questions and provided suggestions.
