I.Treasury Report

 will remove them and add Ken.
- Poinsettia earnings have not yet been added. The money for the ski trip, Hershey bears
 game and recharter have not yet been deducted. Tracy will update once she has all of the
 information.
- For any scouts that have aged out or left the troop, Tracy will move the money into the campership funds (amounts are minimal).

II.Old Business

- Discussion on profits from poinsettia sales. For chicken BBQ the profits were split 50/50 between the troop and the scouts. The troop needs to purchase new tents and will need a new trailer. For this year's poinsettia sales, the committee agreed that the troop will make 10% of the profits and the remainder goes to scout accounts.
- Becky Anderson will take over the poinsettia sale from Maureen Beiler next year.
