### **I.Treasury Report**

- Budget update

Checkbook balance	\$12,555.15
Scout accounts	2,129.74
Campership fund	1,508.06
Veteran's memorial fund	301.68
Total Troop Fund	\$8,615.67

- Summer camp money has been taken out of scout accounts.
- Almost all scouts have positive account balances.
- Links to individual scout accounts is not working at this time.
- All scout accounts are up to date with the exception of credit for Chicken BBQ Sales.

### **II.Old Business**

- Adopt a highway, mulching the church playground, and camping out at the Anderson farm on May 15 went well! Scouts had fun and the weather was perfect. Thank you to Rebecca Anderson for organizing and allowing the scouts to camp out!!
- Chicken BBQ – Ken is working on the spreadsheet for scout earnings. \$995 total profit (includes \$85 in donations). Half goes to troop and the other half will be divided into scout accounts based on presales and hours worked. Troop only had 147 presold tickets (only 8 out of 20 scouts presold). Sold a total of 350 chickens and sold out prior to 12:30. May change the 'guarantee' time to earlier next year as some people showed up and chickens were already sold out. Thoughts for next year are to offer a buyout for scouts who do not sell any tickets, as this fundraiser is also to raise money for the Troop account, not just individual scout accounts. Parents agreed to do this again as a fundraiser and pick the date earlier (April 9<sup>th</sup>) to get in before other BBQs. Possibly give incentives for different levels of scout sales.

### **III.New Business**

- Reminder that when a signup doodle is sent out for any event, we need every scout to **PLEASE** respond yes or no with your availability for planning purposes.
- Barnstormers Scout Night is June 25<sup>th</sup> – Eli will be the contact and needs final count by June 11<sup>th</sup>. A doodle will be sent out for signing up.
- Summer Camp at Hawk Mountain June 27-July 3. 3 copies of Medical forms for camp are due tonight along with copies of front/back of insurance cards (scouts and adults). More information will be provided about leaving for camp as we get closer.
- Scouts working on Cooking merit badge need to cook meals while backpacking. Looking at August 14-15<sup>th</sup> at Peavine Island.
- Parent Committee agreed to not do the council Popcorn Fundraiser.
- Meeting on June 15<sup>th</sup> scouts will work on Toten Chip because scouts need it to bring a pocketknife to summer camp
- Meeting on June 22<sup>nd</sup> scouts will make sure all prerequisites are complete and trailer is ready.
- Possible future activities – swimming at Trussells (Cindy will look into dates), bike hike, mini golf
