Camp Card 2015

What is it: The Camp Card Program is a fundraising program to help Scouts earn their way to camp or for the unit to raise dollars to support its camping and activities throughout the year.

How does it work: We are securing 2015 vendor-partners now who will provide discounts to consumers. These consumers will purchase the card for \$5.00, the unit keeps \$2.50 of each card sold for camp fees or other outdoor program activities. The Council uses the other \$2.50 to pay for the card and support the programs of the Council.

In 2014: 65 Units earned \$33,000 for their Camping and Outdoor Programs. This was a 51% increase over 2013
