Also did not hear back from Restaurant Store – they donated \$75 in past to buy containers. Discussion that for future, maybe we make it all dinners with just a ½ chicken and baked potato to make it easier? Do we continue to do the sale if less profits because of losing donations? Need to sell at least 600-700 chickens to make it worthwhile. However, there are some good lessons for the boys in being responsible for the tickets and money and interacting with customers. Will discuss a decision for next year at the next parent committee meeting on 2/23, as we always confirm our date with Charlie for the following year on the day of the BBQ. There also was a question about changing the date so it is not in March when the weather might not cooperate and impact sales. The reason we do it in March is because that is when Charlie is available (he is booked the rest of the season a year in advance), and we like to be the first chicken BBQ of the season.
